AWARDS SCHOLARSHIPS

For the 28th year running, Lion-Parkson Foundation (LPF) awarded scholarships totalling RM360,000 to 9 undergraduates for the entire duration of their studies based on their academic performance, extra-curricular activities and leadership qualities. The awards were presented by LPF Chairman, Puan Sri Chelsia Cheng witnessed by LPF Trustees, Datuk CS Tang and Dr Chua Siew Kiat; and the students' parents and families on 17 August 2018.

The scholars received RM10,000 per annum for the duration of their studies. Puan Sri Chelsia Cheng in her speech said, "The awards are in line with Lion Group's aspiration to contribute to the country's educational and human resources development in order to achieve economic growth. We hope to nurture educated and talented young Malaysians

who will help to shape and build a better tomorrow for future generations".

The scholars will undergo training in soft skills such as problem-solving and communication skills and internships at our companies during their semester breaks to prepare them for the corporate world, and upon graduation, will be attached to companies in the various divisions according to their field of study.

LPF was launched in 1990 to administer and disburse funds for various needs such as education, charity and scientific research. To date, it has sponsored a total of 457 students through various sponsorship programmes worth RM10.7 million. In addition, LPF has also contributed another RM27 million towards other causes, making a total contribution of RM37.7 million.

YAYASAN LION-PARKSON ANUGERAH BIASISWA

Untuk tahun yang ke-28 berturut-turut, Yayasan Lion-Parkson (LPF) menganugerahkan biasiswa berjumlah RM360,000 kepada 9 orang siswazah untuk sepanjang tempoh pengajian mereka berdasarkan prestasi akademik, aktiviti kokurikulum dan kualiti kepimpinan. Anugerah tersebut disampaikan oleh Pengerusi LPF, Puan Sri Chelsia Cheng disaksikan oleh Pemegang Amanah LPF, Datuk CS Tang dan Dr Chua Siew Kiat; ibu bapa dan keluarga pelajar pada 17 Ogos 2018.

Masing-masing akan menerima biasiswa bernilai RM10,000 setahun bagi setiap tahun pengajian. Puan Sri Chelsia Cheng dalam ucapannya berkata, "Anugerah ini selaras dengan aspirasi Kumpulan Lion untuk menyumbang kepada pembangunan pendidikan dan sumber manusia negara bagi mencapai pertumbuhan ekonomi. Kami berharap dapat memupuk golongan belia Malaysia yang berpendidikan dan

berbakat yang dapat membantu membentuk dan membina masa depan yang lebih baik untuk generasi akan datang".

Para penerima biasiswa juga berpeluang menjalani latihan seperti kemahiran menangani masalah dan komunikasi serta latihan industri di syarikat-syarikat Kumpulan Lion semasa cuti semester sebagai persediaan kepada dunia korporat, dan apabila tamat pengajian, mereka akan berkhidmat di syarikat-syarikat kita mengikut bidang pengajian mereka.

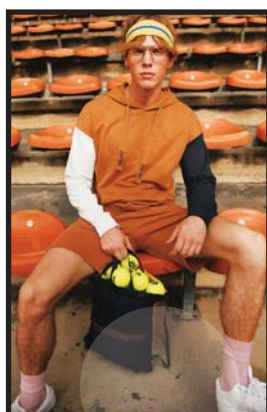

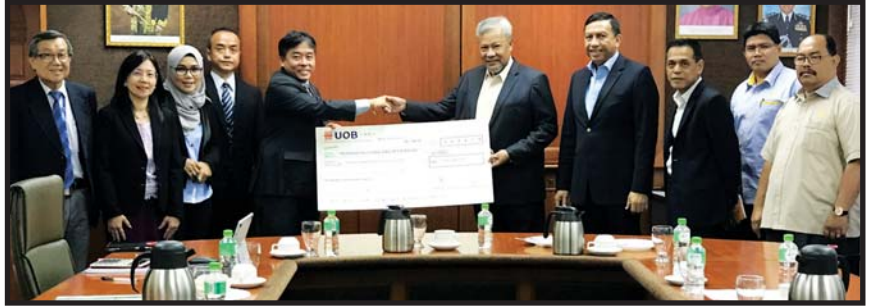

1. Star Wars (the original trilogy)

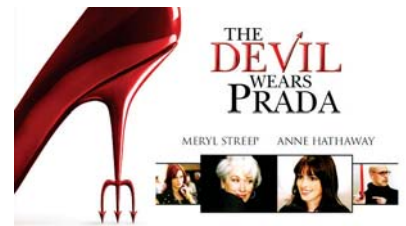

He encourages them to challenge themselves, he doesn't let them slack and he provides motivational words to inspire them. In return, he is rewarded with a huge amount of loyalty. Yoda's there for his students, he's patient and he's willing to share his wealth of knowledge.

Conversely, we have a great example of a poor manager in the form of Darth Vader. He isn't clear with his team on what he expects of them, but then he gets infuriated and lashes out when his unarticulated expectations aren't met. As Gallup points out, employees need to know what their goals are. Otherwise, they are bound to disappoint you. Vader's other huge downfall is that he tries to manage through the medium of terror. As most HR executives are aware, fear is never a good motivator. Rather than instantly resorting to the Force Choke, Vader would be better served sitting his employees down and discussing their performance.

On top of this, Miranda Priestly is a terrifying manager who created a toxic work environment. Around her, employees never feel at ease or able to communicate. Employees shouldn't feel like they're constantly one small accident away from losing their jobs. A good manager appreciates that mistakes are a part of growing and learning and they are able to turn these mistakes into learning opportunities.

3. Kung Fu Panda



Leadership lessons can come from the strangest of sources. In this case, it comes in the form of a cartoon panda. We should all be grateful that the youth of today is being exposed to inspiring lessons that will help shape their future. That's not to say that fully-grown executives can't learn a thing or two from Pixar, too.

In the first Kung Fu Panda film, we learn an important management lesson from Master Shifu. He comes to realize that Po the Panda is a unique soul who isn't motivated by the same things as his other students. Taking this on board, Shifu finds other ways to incentivize, reward and encourage his new recruit. With the use of food, Shifu is able to engage Po and supercharge his performance. Managers who don't bother getting to know their employees and discovering what really motivates them risk losing out on their potential.

LEARN NET MEETING - GAMIFICATION IN HR 13 JULY 2018



The one day training workshop focused on the application of gamification in reshaping employees experience with behavioral change to motivate participation, engagement, loyalty, and productivity in the workplace. The workshop was part of CeDR's Learn Net meetings, one of the many initiatives set by CeDR to expose its team to new learning & development approaches.

What is gamification?
